## **FRIDAY, MARCH 3:**

Many young Precept leaders and students in schools in African countries are preparing for exams, please pray for them. Ask for God's favour, encouragement and strength over them during this time.

## **SATURDAY, MARCH 4:**

Pray for the How to Study & Lead Precept Upon Precept training happening in Cape Town, South Africa today. Pray that it will lead to new leaders passionate to start classes of their own.

## **SUNDAY, MARCH 5:**

Stuart leaves Tanzania and travels to Madagascar today to lead a 2-week Precept Institute in the country. Please lift up each student and ask God to use this time in the Word to deepen their passion for Himself and His Word.

## **MONDAY, MARCH 6:**

The 3rd session of the Precept South Africa Institute starts today. Lift up Simeon as he leads and each student. May there be no obstacles during the next 2-weeks that will prevent the Institute from being completed.

Pray for the Ekiti pastor meetings in Nigeria this week, ask that God would use these days to encourage these faithful leaders to build churches grounded in God's Word.

## **FRIDAY, MARCH 10:**

Please pray for the Bible study classes in Ghana today. Ask God to use these groups to raise up new Bible study leaders and classes across the country.

## **SATURDAY, MARCH 11:**

Lift up all the hub students across Africa that join the Institute online, especially those in far-to-reach areas. May they remain committed to completing the 2-week sessions despite being in remote areas.

## **SUNDAY, MARCH 12:**

Today lift up the teams in the different countries as they continue to strengthen partnerships with large denominations and expand their outreach.

## **MONDAY, MARCH 13:**

Pray for all the faithful Precept Africa financial partners. Ask God to bless them in their ministry of giving and pray that more people would know God deeply because of their support.

## **TUESDAY, MARCH 14:**

Precept South Africa is working on various school projects, especially in the KZN and PE regions. Ask God to use the studies to fill the



teachers and students with great excitement for His Word.

**WEDNESDAY, MARCH 15:**

Ask God today to raise leaders and volunteers in Sierra Leone and to expand the ministry

**THURSDAY, MARCH 16:**

Please pray for the Bible study leaders in Kenya, pray that God will use them to mentor and encourage others to become leaders.

**FRIDAY, MARCH 17:**

**SATURDAY, MARCH 25:**

Please pray that God will raise up more men to start Bible study groups in South Africa this year.

**SUNDAY, MARCH 26:**

Today, lift up all the pastors across the continent who are preaching the true Gospel, ask God to strengthen and encourage them to remain steadfast.

**MONDAY, MARCH 27:**

The Study the Word Program begins today in South Africa. Pray that the students will grow in their understanding of God and His Word as they study this week.
