MONDAY, MAY 1:

Pray that each Precept event/ training happening this month would result in many, new passionate Bible study leaders.

TUESDAY, MAY 2:

Hubs in Tanzania will be joining the online Precept Africa Institute for the first time next week. Please pray that no obstacles will stand in the way of this becoming a reality.

WEDNESDAY, MAY 3:

Lift up the Precept Africa volunteers in the Comoros who passionately teach the Word of God despite persecution in this predominately Muslim country.

THURSDAY, MAY 4:

As the need for studies in local languages grows exponentially across Africa, please pray for the Precept translation teams. Ask God to give them good time management and accuracy so that there is no delay in the translation process.

FRIDAY, MAY 5:

Precept South Africa is in the process of employing an office administrator, please pray that the Lord will guide and lead this process.

SATURDAY, MAY 6:

Persecution and unrest are increasing in many African countries. Please pray for the protection of the Precept teams, leaders and students who face danger as they travel to studies, workshops etc.

SUNDAY, MAY 7:

Pray for the team in Kenya as they look for more volunteers to help the ministry grow across the country.

MONDAY, MAY 8:

Today is the first day of a new 2-week Precept Africa Institute. Pray for Stuart as he leads and for each student as they study and prepare to share God's Word with others.

TUESDAY, MAY 9:

Pray for Simeon who is in Pretoria this week meeting with and encouraging church leaders.

WEDNESDAY, MAY 10:

Pray for the launch of the newly translated 40-Minute study into Luganda in Uganda. Ask God to use the study to bring many into a deeper relationship with Himself.

THURSDAY, MAY 11:

Ask God to transform the hearts of the secondary school children in Sierra Leone who are using Precept studies in their schools.

FRIDAY, MAY 12:

Forty-one young people have come to a saving faith through a Precept youth event in Nigeria so far this year. Lift up these young people and ask God to strengthen and grow their faith.

SATURDAY, MAY 13:

Pray that the leadership teams in the different countries would have a clear, unified vision as they establish people in their nations in God's Word.

SUNDAY, MAY 14:

Ask God to provide more opportunities for Precept Kenya to start Bible studies in local schools.

MONDAY, MAY 15:

Please lift up the training workshops in Cape Town today and tomorrow, please pray that this will lead to new leaders who will disciple many with God's Word.



TUESDAY, MAY 16:

Ask God to give wisdom and guidance to the team working in Ghana.

WEDNESDAY, MAY 17:

Please ask God to protect the team that travels to different refugee camps to encourage Precept groups.

THURSDAY, MAY 18:

Please pray for the Precept Africa leadership team as they strategize and plan to extend Precept's reach in Zambia.

FRIDAY, MAY 19:

Today is the last day of the Precept Africa Institute, please pray that these students will continue to dive deep into Scripture and lead their own groups.

SATURDAY, MAY 20:

Please pray for the planning underway for next month's Precept Winter Youth Conference with an informal settlement church in South Africa.

SUNDAY, MAY 21:

Today, please ask God to use Precept resources to draw more people to Himself in Africa.

MONDAY, MAY 22:

Pray for the team in Togo. Pray for connections with church leaders across the country who will start Bible studies in local congregations.

TUESDAY, MAY 23:

Please pray for the provision of a visa for pastor Nirina in Precept Madagascar who is needing it for a mission trip to La Réunion. Ask God to remove all the barriers that are stopping ministry from happening in this country.

WEDNESDAY, MAY 24:

Pray that God will increase the number of young people who are meeting in Precept study groups in universities across the continent.

THURSDAY, MAY 25:

Please pray for the Precept team in South Africa. Ask God to help them raise up more volunteers to help coordinate ministry events.

FRIDAY, MAY 26:

Ask God to raise young Precept Bible study leaders who will lead in the secondary schools where Precept studies are being done.

SATURDAY, MAY 27:

Pray for the many Precept Africa Institute students as they prepare to graduate next month, and ask God to use them to extend the ministry's reach in their countries.

SUNDAY, MAY 28:

Please lift up the Precept leaders in Uganda, especially the groups meeting in impoverished rural areas.

MONDAY, MAY 29:

Precept Kenya continues to impact 350 prisoners each week in Nanyuki prison alone. Pray that God will encourage the volunteers who teach Living Victoriously in Difficult Times in this prison each week and that He will use this study to draw many to Himself.

TUESDAY, MAY 30:

Lift up the team in Nigeria as they prepare for the Precept Youth Clubs to be held during the coming school holidays. The invitations will get distributed over the coming weeks, ask God to draw many young people to register.

WEDNESDAY, MAY 31:

Pray for the study groups in Bible colleges in Madagascar, ask God to use these students to impact many in their communities with God's Word.
