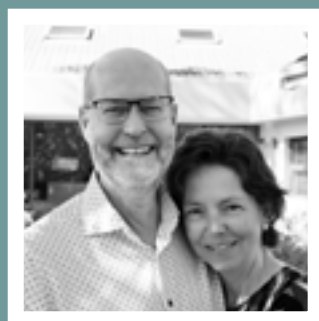

## Growing Faith and Character

For eight years, volunteer Mrs. Ogundipe Oluwabukola Kremi has faithfully disciplined children through God's Word. Her consistent investment has nurtured young hearts in the love and fear of the Lord, with countless testimonies of children growing in faith and applying Scripture in their daily lives.



Children in Nigeria are growing up hearing daily reports of horrific kidnappings and the deaths of young people in their country. From a very young age, many are learning what it means to stand firm in their faith and face persecution as a result. Can you imagine living under such a constant cloud of fear? This makes the patient work of discipleship especially valuable. **Through leaders like Mrs. Kremi, children have the opportunity to encounter God's Word, ask honest questions and learn what it looks like to follow Him in everyday life.** We are deeply grateful for leaders who give their time and energy to invest in the next generation, and it is a joy to see young lives being shaped by the truth of Scripture.

The Precept Computer Club in Nigeria continues to be a safe place where young people grow in both faith and practical skills. Thanks to the generous donation of 20 new computers earlier this year, even more students are engaging in Bible study before developing valuable computer skills. **What a privilege to see future leaders being grounded in God's Word, equipped to stand for Christ and mentored to reach their generation with the Good News.**



Using the 40-Minute Study: *How to Make Choices You Won't Regret*, the students are learning to apply the same careful thinking and decision-making skills to God's Word and to their own lives. It is a beautiful way to connect the digital world with discipleship—helping the next generation develop both practical skills and Biblical character.

## Equipping Young Leaders

Following in Nigeria's footsteps, **Uganda has launched its very first Precept Computer Club, bringing together 40 teenagers from four different churches.** The club creates an exciting space where young people can develop practical computer skills that can serve them well in their education, future careers and everyday lives. **But alongside technology, they are also being equipped with something even more foundational: the wisdom to make choices that honour God.**



As technology continues to shape their world, we are excited to see young people learning not only how to use it, but how to navigate that world with wisdom, integrity and a heart surrendered to God.

# Reaping the Fruit of Faith

One Teacher's audacious Prayer Transforms Lives.



In 2022, a teacher at Sakhumuzi Primary School in Pongola, KwaZulu-Natal, discovered Precept's Bible study books for children. As she looked at the resources, a simple question came to her heart: *"Lord, what is the chance that each of the children in my class can have a book like this?"* She brought that desire before God, trusting Him with a prayer that seemed bigger than what she could provide herself.



At the same time, she was studying through Precept's Precept Upon Precept study of Jeremiah and came across **Jeremiah 32:27**: **"I am the LORD of all mankind. Is anything too hard for Me?"** What began as a quiet prayer became a reminder of God's ability to do what seemed impossible.

Today, that prayer is becoming a reality. Through the generosity of Precept Africa supporters, nine teachers at Sakhumuzi Primary School are now able to learn from and share God's Word with children in Grades 1, 2 and 3. **These books are more than educational resources; they are an opportunity for teachers to open Scripture with young hearts and minds and help children discover God and the life-giving truth of His Word.**

The teachers expressed their deep gratitude for this special gift, describing it as an opportunity to plant seeds of God's Word in the hearts of the next generation. They are excited to learn alongside their learners and to see how these lessons shape their understanding of God. **What began with one teacher's simple prayer is now reaching classrooms across the school—a beautiful reminder that nothing is too hard for God.**

## Young People Living Differently

Across six high schools in Kenya, nine Bible study groups are meeting alongside H.U.G.S. for Africa programmes, exploring questions and challenges that matter deeply to young people. Their growing hunger to know God and understand His Word is both inspiring and encouraging. These students are not simply learning Bible facts—they are asking what Scripture means for their lives and how they can put God's truth into practice.

The choice of studies is particularly meaningful for this age group. At three schools, students are working through *How to Make Choices You Won't Regret*, learning to consider their decisions in light of God's Word as they navigate adolescence and begin making increasingly significant choices for themselves. At three others, students are studying *What Does the Bible Say About Sex?* – giving them a safe, Biblical foundation for understanding God's design for sexuality and relationships at an age when these questions become increasingly relevant.

There is something especially encouraging about seeing teenagers take their faith seriously. These young people are discovering that following God is not simply about what they believe on Sundays, but about how they choose to live every day. **They are learning to bring real questions, real decisions and real pressures to Scripture, and to allow God's Word to shape their choices. What a privilege it is to see young people seeking to know God for themselves.**

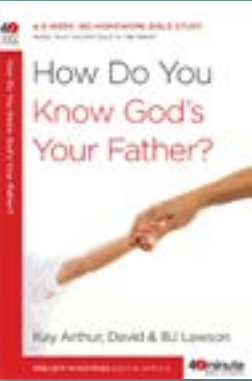
We are incredibly proud of these students and excited about what God is doing among the youth of Kenya. With this one partnership, sixty-four girls and boys are currently studying *How to Make Choices You Won't Regret*, while another 39 are studying *What does the Bible says about sex?* **They are taking ownership of their faith, learning to seek God's wisdom and choosing to live according to His Word. We celebrate their commitment and pray that what they are learning now will shape the men and women they become.**



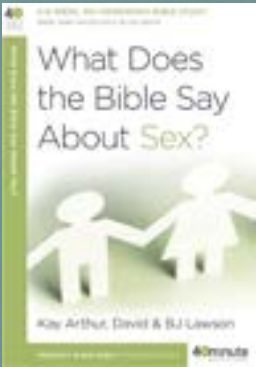

# Get to Know

## ZAMBIA

Nestled in the heart of Southern Africa, Zambia is home to around 19 million people, with Lusaka as its capital. Known for the mighty Mosi-oa-Tunya Waterfall fed by the Zambezi River, the country is also rich in wildlife, natural beauty and cultural heritage. **Zambia is home to more than 70 ethnic groups, including the Bemba, Nyanja-Chewa, and Tonga, each contributing their own languages, traditions and celebrations to the nation's vibrant**



Zambia has a long history of Christian mission and church life, with historic sites such as Niamkolo Church, built in 1895 and recognised as the oldest surviving church building in the country. Today, that faith heritage continues through local leaders who are investing in the next generation and helping people discover the truth of God's Word for themselves.
